**RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ICED LOAN TO
N.H. OWENS & SON FUNERAL HOME**

Cheryl Owens dba N.H. Owens & Son Funeral Home (the “Applicant”), has submitted to the EDGE Economic Development Finance Committee (the “Committee”) of the Economic Development Growth Engine Industrial Development Board of the City of Memphis and County of Shelby, Tennessee (the “Board”) an application for an Inner City Economic Development (“ICED”) forgivable loan to assist the Applicant in improving the exterior appearance, weatherproof entrances and improve disabled accessibility at 421 Scott Street, Memphis, Tennessee (the “Application”).

WITH RESPECT THERETO, the Committee hereby resolves as follows:

1. Based on the representations set forth in the Application and the recommendation of the staff of the Board, as summarized in the attached term sheet, which is incorporated herein by reference, the Committee on behalf of the Board hereby awards and agrees to provide the Applicant an Eighteen Thousand Dollar (\$18,000.00) forgivable loan (the “Loan”). The Loan will assist the Applicant in improving the exterior appearance, weatherproof entrances and improve disabled accessibility at 421 Scott Street, Memphis, Tennessee.
2. Approval of the project is contingent upon review and approval of the project by the EDGE architect.
3. The Board Chairman and any other officer of the Board are authorized to execute any and all documents related to the Loan on behalf of the Board.
