RESOLUTION TO APPROVE ICED LOAN TO PYRAMID STONE INC.

Chuck Laminack, Jr., d/b/a Pyramid Stone Inc., a Tennessee corporation (the “Applicant”), has submitted to the Economic Development Finance Committee (the “Committee”) of the Economic Development Growth Engine Industrial Development Board of the City of Memphis and County of Shelby, Tennessee (the “EDGE Board”) an application for an Inner City Economic Development (“ICED”) loan to assist the Applicant in making facade and interior improvements and renovations at 2615 Summer Avenue, Memphis, Tennessee (the “Application”).

WITH RESPECT THERETO, the Committee hereby resolves as follows:

1. Based on the representations set forth in the Application and the recommendation of the staff of the Board, as summarized in the attached term sheet, which is incorporated herein by reference, the Committee on behalf of the Board hereby awards and agrees to provide the Applicant a \$25,000 loan (the “Loan”). The Loan will assist the Applicant in making facade and interior improvements and renovations at 2886 Walnut Grove Road, Memphis, Tennessee.
2. The Board Chairman and any other officer of the Board are authorized to execute any and all documents related to the Loan on behalf of the Board.
